DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES: *APPLICANT MUST RESIDE IN CHATHAM COUNTY OR A SURROUNDING COUNTY OR BE WILLING TO RELOCATE.* Inspects red meat, red meat products, and meat processing facilities to determine compliance with regulatory standards. This includes ante-mortem, post-mortem, and sanitation inspections. This position requires that you have your own personal transportation and be willing to work in adjoining areas as dictated by program requirements (travel outside circuit is expected to be less than 15%).

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Meat Inspector 1 – Completion of high school diploma or GED AND One year of experience in the area of assignment

OR

Completion of two years of college which included 12 semester/20 quarter hours in chemistry or life sciences

OR

Completion of a vocational-technical program in agriculture, horticulture, environmental science, pest control, entomology or a close related field.

Meat Inspector 2 - Completion of two years of college which included 12 semester/20 quarter hours in chemistry or life sciences

OR

Completion of a vocational-technical program in agriculture, horticulture, environmental science, pest control, entomology or a close related field

AND

One year of experience in a directly related area

OR

Two years of experience at an equivalent to the lower level.

NOTE: If you are applying for this position based on the college credit, please submit a copy of your **official** college transcript to help determine if you meet the qualifications for this position. Failure to submit a transcript will result in not being eligible for this specific position.

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS: *Preference will be given to applicants, who, in addition to meeting the Minimum Qualifications, possess knowledge, skills and abilities in the following areas:*

- State or Federal Meat and/or Food Inspection experience;
- Completion of a bachelor's degree from a 4 year college or university in Animal Science, Environmental Science, Biology or a close related field.;
- Computer skills including knowledge and experience with Microsoft Windows is desirable.
