The Georgia f.o.b. dock quoted price on broilers and fryers for this week's trading is 94.00¢ based on full truck load lots of ice pack USDA grade "A" sized 2½ to 3 pound birds. 76% (representing 751 loads) of the loads offered have been confirmed within a range of 88.14¢ to 99.89¢ with a preliminary weighted average of 93.48¢ f.o.b. dock or equivalent. The market is firm and the live supply is adequate to occasionally short for a mostly good holiday demand. Average weights are desirable to lighter than desired in a few instances. Estimated slaughter today is 4,607,100 head. This compares with 4,944,000 head last Friday.

The f.o.b. dock confirmed preliminary weighted average prices on ice pack parts based on truck load and pool truck load lots for this week's trading are: line run tenders \$2.2050 (based on 984,000 lbs.); skinless boneless breasts \$1.73 (based on 4,367,000 lbs.); whole breasts \$1.06¢ (based on 920,000 lbs.); boneless skinless thigh meat \$1.3950 (based on 816,000 lbs.); thighs 75.50¢ (based on 742,000 lbs.); drumsticks 75.00¢ (based on 734,000 lbs.); leg quarters 55.00¢ (based on 5,304,000 lbs.); and wings \$1.8150 (based on 2,195,000 lbs.).
