Staying Vigilant - PPD's Continued Efforts to Track Yellow-Legged Hornets:

The Plant Protection Division (PPD) team continues to closely monitor Yellow-Legged Hornet (YLH) activity as the season shifts into the colder months. The team remains vigilant—tracking any signs of hornet activity and thoroughly investigating potential nest sites. Their work is far from finished; as long as worker hornets remain active, the search for additional nests will continue. The PPD team remains fully committed to careful monitoring and diligent nest detection throughout the season.
